**A RESOLUTION REGARDING CERTAIN CHANGES TO
COLORADO SPRINGS UTILITIES' ELECTRIC RATE TARIFF**

WHEREAS, the United States Air Force Academy ("Academy") has requested safe and reliable electric and facilities service from Colorado Springs Utilities; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2008, by Resolution No. 140-08, the City Council approved a resolution in response to the Academy's request to provide electric and facilities service within the geographic confines of the Academy; and

WHEREAS, since August 2008, when additional funds have become available or additional project segments authorized, the Academy has requested revisions in the tariff to recover the costs of the electric and facilities service; and

WHEREAS, the Academy determined that additional funds are available for additional projects to the electrical infrastructure on the Academy's grounds and requested a tariff revisions to facilitate the construction of those projects which will then be owned and operated by Colorado Springs Utilities; and

WHEREAS, the proposed tariff modifications are designed to implement revised billing charges toward recovery of the costs to fund the Academy's requested electric system projects; and

WHEREAS, any funds collected through the proposed tariff shall be applied to the cost of the Academy's requested projects, or upon the Academy's request, be applied to the Academy's charges for standard electric service; and

WHEREAS, the Academy has requested these tariff modifications and has provided a letter in support of the tariff modifications; and

WHEREAS, City Code section 12.1.107(D)(2)(f) provides that the City Council may change any tariff provision which City Council, in its discretion, deems to be appropriate, provided, that the change has no adverse impact on customers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the proposed modifications to the Electric Rate Schedule, Contract Service will not adversely impact other customers; and

WHEREAS, the proposed modifications to the Electric Rate Schedules are just, reasonable, sufficient and not unduly discriminatory and allow Colorado Springs Utilities to collect revenues that enable Colorado Springs Utilities to continue to operate in the best interest of all of its customers; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Springs Utilities has proposed to make the Electric Rate Schedule changes effective March 1, 2017, and subsequently terminate automatically, without further action on November 1, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1: That Colorado Springs Utilities Tariff, City Council Volume No. 5, Electric Rate Schedules shall be revised as follows:

Effective March 1, 2017, and terminating November 1, 2017:
