Re: Collocation letter for CM1 Conditional Use application for WCF at 4575 Galley Road

Mr. Alcuran-

This letter is respectfully submitted in accordance with Section 7.4.608.B.6 of the City of Colorado Springs Zoning ordinance regarding Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CMRS) Regulations for Wireless Communications Facilities.

Crown Castle has been part of the national communications community since 1994, possessing approximately 40,000 cell towers hosting approximately 91,000 carrier installations ("collocations"). Crown Castle's extensive infrastructure including fiber and small cells as well as towers, serves as the backbone of the nation's communication networks.

As one of the nation's leaders in the communications infrastructure industry, Crown Castle is an unwavering proponent of collocation, provided the site can structurally, spatially, and technically accommodate additional CMRS users.

With regard to the proposed site at 5590 North Nevada Avenue, the site will be designed to accommodate the relocation of the Sprint/T-Mobile facility currently on site and the addition of at least two additional CMRS users.
