A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF  
COLORADO SPRINGS TRANSIT CENTER RELOCATION  
STEERING COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDATION

WHEREAS, the existing Downtown Transit Terminal does not adequately meet the existing and future operational needs of the City's transit system or provide adequate multimodal connections; and

WHEREAS, the existing Downtown Transit Terminal lacks independent vehicular access and egress, and lacks quality internal pedestrian access and circulation; and

WHEREAS, the existing Downtown Transit Terminal lacks an inviting and pleasant physical environment; and

WHEREAS, a downtown transit station relocation study was completed in November 2016, that identified three recommended sites for a new downtown transit center, based on an extensive technical analysis and significant community involvement; and

WHEREAS, a Mayor-appointed steering committee comprised of two City Council Members and other community stakeholders prioritized the three recommended sites and made further recommendations to Mayor John Suthers as set forth in the City of Colorado Springs Transit Center Relocation Steering Committee's ("Steering Committee") recommendation, attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit A**; and

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2017, during a meeting with the Steering Committee, Mayor John Suthers accepted the Steering Committee's recommendation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:**

Section 1. That the City of Colorado Springs Transit Center Relocation Steering Committee's recommendation, attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein, is hereby accepted and adopted.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
