

ORDINANCE NO. 17-5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 703 (WASTEWATER DISCHARGE; LIMITATIONS) OF PART 7 (PROHIBITIONS – LIMITATIONS ON WASTEWATER DISCHARGE) OF ARTICLE 5 (WASTEWATER TREATMENT CODE) OF CHAPTER 12 (UTILITIES) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO WASTEWATER DISCHARGE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 703 (Wastewater Discharge; Limitations) of Part 7 (Prohibitions – Limitations on Wastewater Discharge) of Article 5 (Wastewater Treatment Code) of Chapter 12 (Utilities) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

12.5.703: WASTEWATER DISCHARGE; LIMITATIONS:

B. Local Limitations: For each significant industrial user, the following tables set forth the local limits on the daily maximum limit (milligrams per liter) and maximum allowable industrial loading (pounds per day) of pollutants, as measured by a composite sample and related flow measurements taken during the user's operating day, unless elsewhere specified in this article or in the significant industrial user's wastewater discharge permit.


