

RESOLUTION NO. ____-19

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE MOUNTAIN METRO TRANSIT ROUTE 8 PEDESTRIAN AND TRANSIT ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) is providing funds for construction of the Mountain Metro Transit Route 8 Pedestrian and Transit Accessibility Improvements Project which is identified as Project No. TRG M240-176 (Project Code 23058) (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes §29-1-203, the City Council has the authority to approve an Intergovernmental Agreement (“IGA”) between the City of Colorado Springs (“City”) and CDOT; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to enter into this IGA and allow the City’s Public Works Department to utilize the funding for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the total Project cost is estimated at \$ 1,288,919.00; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide a local match for the Project in the amount of \$ 257,784.00; and

WHEREAS, the IGA between the City and CDOT contemplates acceptance by the City of \$ 1,031,135.00 in federal funds administered by CDOT; and

WHEREAS, the IGA between CDOT and the City must be approved and fully executed to secure the grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the IGA between the City of Colorado Springs and the Colorado Department of Transportation for the funding of the Mountain Metro Transit Route 8 Pedestrian and Transit Accessibility Improvements Project, a copy of which is attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

Section 2. On behalf of the City, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and administer the IGA between the Colorado Department of Transportation and the City of Colorado Springs.
