
- Outside-City water service for
- new Single-Family Residence

Property:

- Lot 1 Fox Rock Subdivision

Lot 1 is:

- not contiguous to City boundary
- not eligible for annexation.




Water Service without Annexation

Utilities to provide water service only upon approval of City Council through ordinance per City Code 7.6.210: Service without Annexation; and with an Agreement to Annex at a future date determined by the City

Eligibility and Requirements

- City Planning Department has determined that the Property is not contiguous to the City boundary and therefore, not currently eligible for annexation
- Utilities Staff and City Planning Department support an Agreement to Annex at a future date after the Property becomes eligible for annexation
- Owner will pay system Development Charges and rates that are 50% higher than inside-City rates
- Park, School, Drainage and Bridge fees paid prior to connection
- Owner responsible for all water service-line construction costs



Lot 1 Fox Rock Subdivision

- Property is an undeveloped, 5-acre lot outside-City that is not contiguous to City limits
- Owner to construct a single-family residence on the lot upon extension of private water service line
- City water service can be provided without an extension of City water distribution system
- City previously committed to provide water service to Fox Rock Subdivision
- The Property is located within CSU's Electric and Natural Gas services territories.

Staff Recommendation

Approval of the Resolution approving the Agreement providing water service to the property known as Lot 1, Fox Rock Subdivision and authorizing the Mayor to execute the Agreement.
