A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING JULY AS
NATIONAL PARK AND RECREATION MONTH

WHEREAS, parks and recreation are an integral part of communities throughout Colorado Springs; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation are vitally important to establishing and maintaining the quality of life in Colorado Springs, ensuring the health of all citizens, and contributing to the economic and environmental well-being of our community and region; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation foster social cohesiveness by celebrating diversity, providing spaces to come together peacefully, promoting social equity, connecting social networks, and ensuring all people have access to its benefits; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation increase a community's economic prosperity through increased property values, expansion of the local tax base, increased tourism, the attraction and retention of businesses, and crime reduction; and


WHEREAS, parks and recreation sustain and steward our natural resources by protecting habitats and open space, connecting people to nature, and promoting the ecological function of parkland; and
