Background

- October 14 City Council Meeting
 - Utilities filed 2015 Rate Case and requested public hearing for November 25
 - Wind Power Electric Rate Schedule tariff sheet
 - Wind Power tariff expires December 31, 2014
 - At that time no replacement wind contract was in place
- November 19 Utilities Board Meeting
 - Approved a two-year extension of the wind contract for 20,000 MWh/year
 - Cost of wind not sold will be recovered from all electric customers
- December 9 City Council Meeting
 - Approved 2015 Rate Case with Wind Power tariff reserved for future use



Review of Rate Filing Timeline

- December 8, 2014 Special Utilities Board Meeting
 - Reviewed anticipated Wind Power Electric Rate Schedule filing
- December 9, 2014 City Council Meeting
 - Request for Hearing to consider Wind Power Electric Rate Schedule
- January 13, 2015 City Council Meeting
 - Public rate hearing
 - Request suspension of Post-Hearing Procedures of City Council
 - Waive the requirement of a Decision and Order
 - Allow immediate approval of Resolution
 - If approved, Wind Power Electric Rate Schedule will be effective January 14, 2015



Wind Power – WPWR Rate Calculation

3	Total Wind Power Cost per kWh (line 1/line 2)	\$	0.0490	
4	Conversion to 1 Block (100 kWh)		100	
5	Energy Charge Rate Per Block (line 3 x line 4)	\$	4.9000	



Wind Contract Cost Under Recovery

- Should there be any unrecovered wind contract costs through this Wind Power tariff, the cost will be recovered from all electric customers through the Electric Cost Adjustment (ECA)
 - Total wind power purchase agreement expense
 - Less: Wind Power revenue
 - Equals cost to be recovered from all electric customers through ECA

- Rate Case Documents posted online December 9, 2014
- Published Legal Notice on December 11, 2014
- Mailed Legal Notice on December 12, 2014



Wind Awareness - Customer Outreach

- Updated website to include:
 - Communication regarding wind program and pricing
 - Rate Case Documents
- Letter sent to all existing wind customers
- Large customers individually contacted
- Utilities anticipates full program subscription
 - Utilities will confirm program subscription level after the January bill cycle
 - If not fully subscribed:
 - Utilities will implement additional awareness campaign
 - Any unsubscribed power is utilized in Utilities' total source of generation to serve all customers
