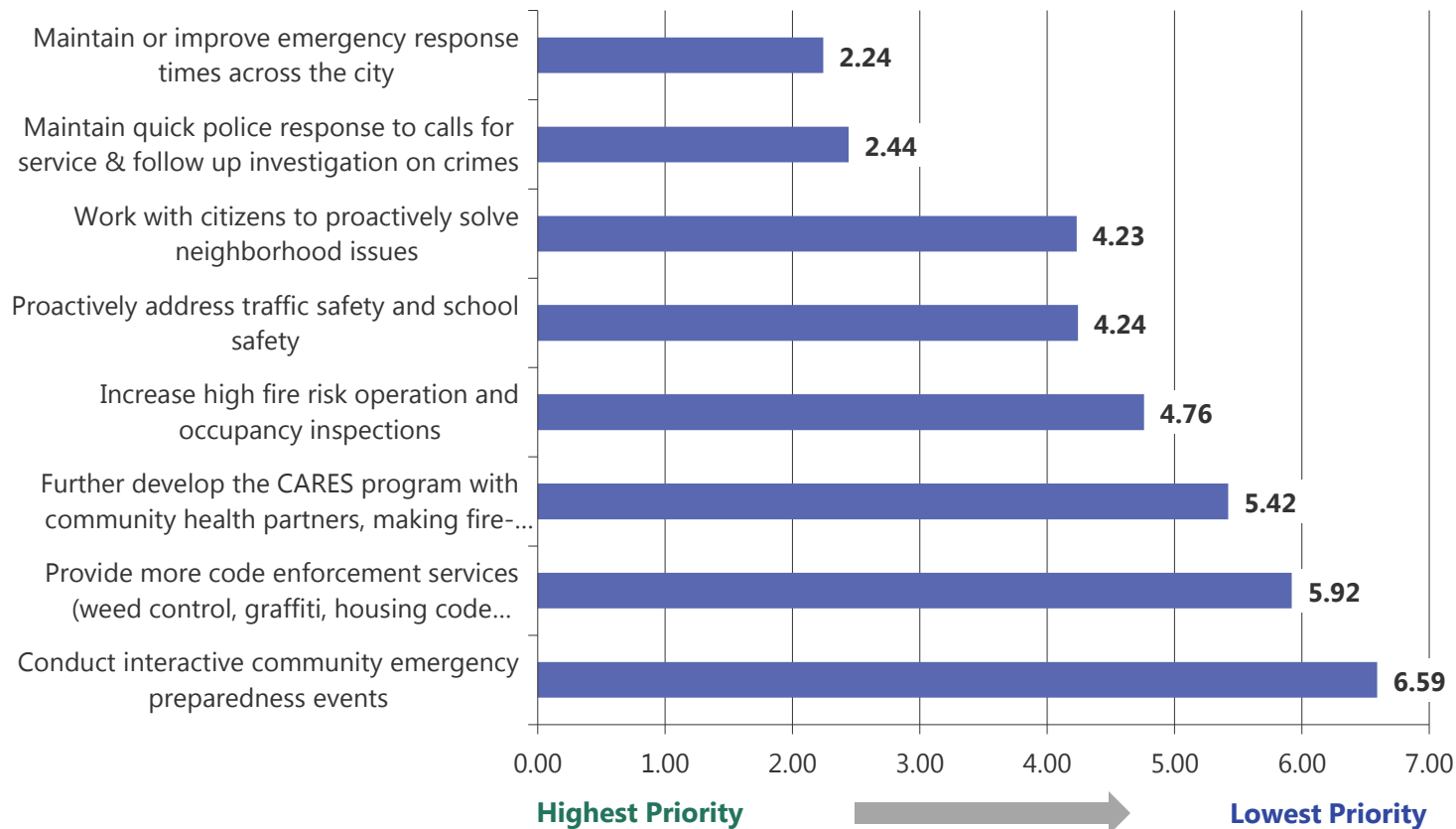
Q1: “How would you prioritize the following services and investments for City funding in 2016?”

(prioritized in rank order, with 1 being the highest)



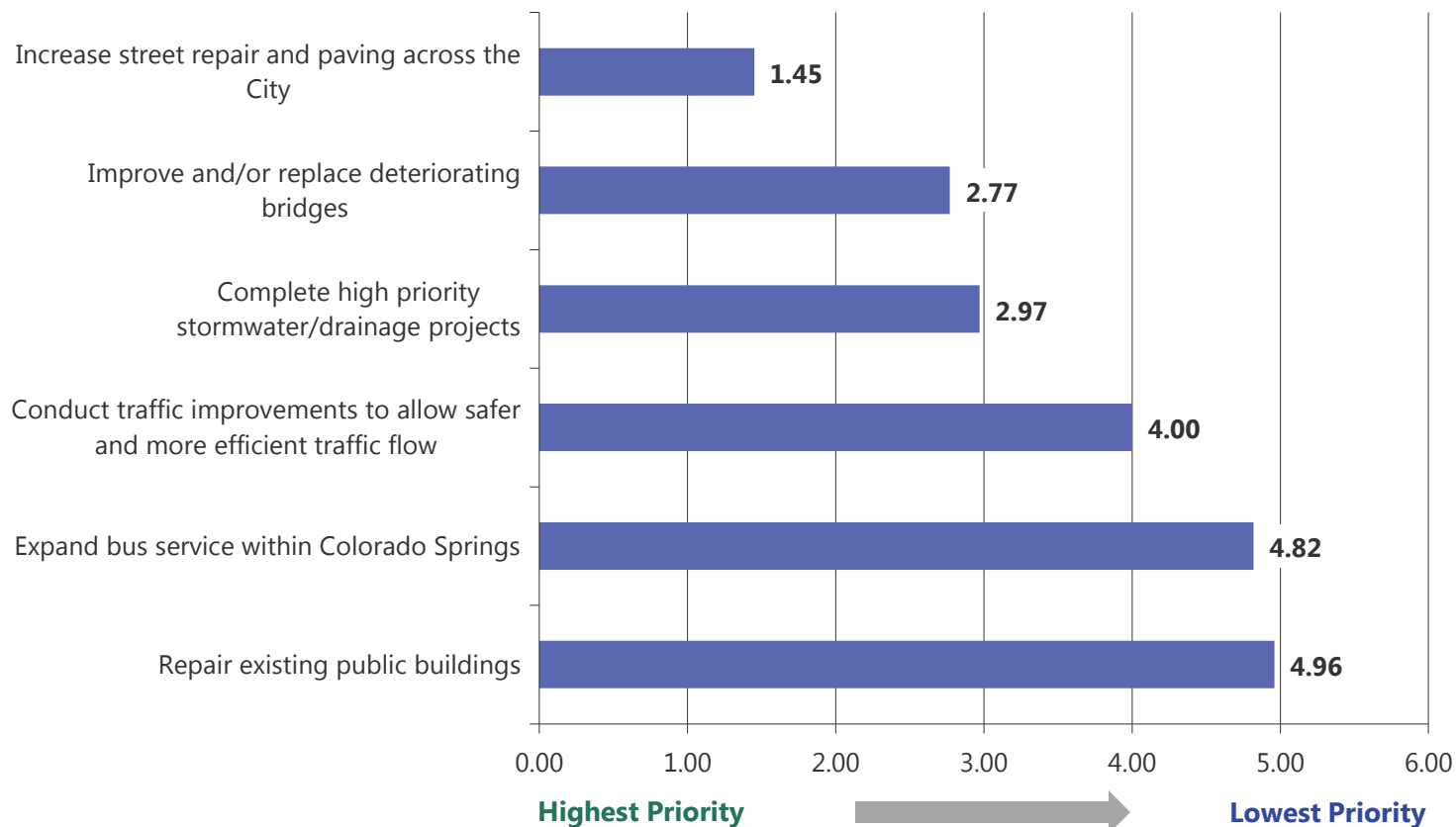
Q2: “How would you prioritize the following services and investments for City funding in 2016?”

(prioritized in rank order, with 1 being the highest)



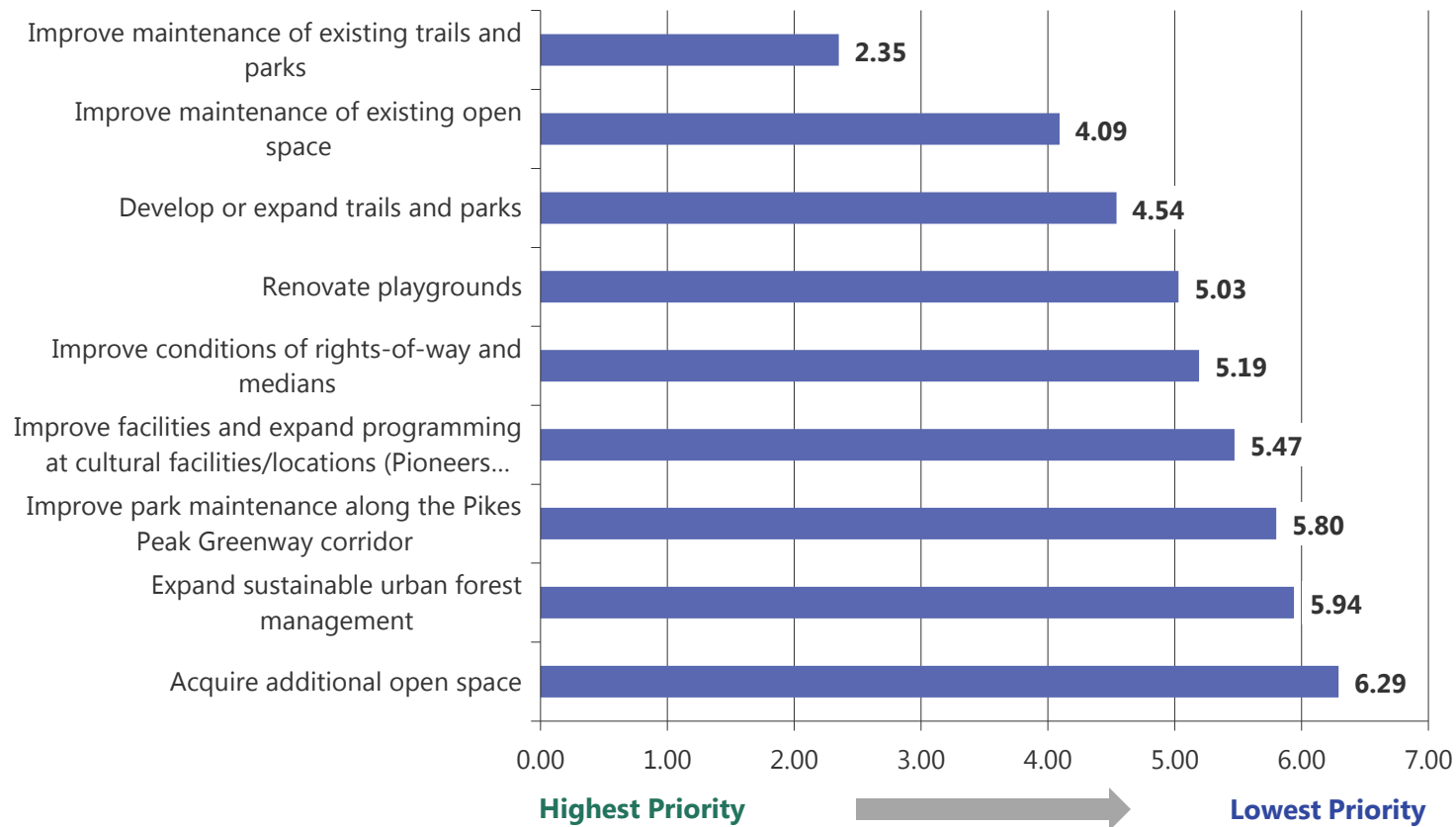
Q3: “How would you prioritize the following services and investments for City funding in 2016?”

(prioritized in rank order, with 1 being the highest)



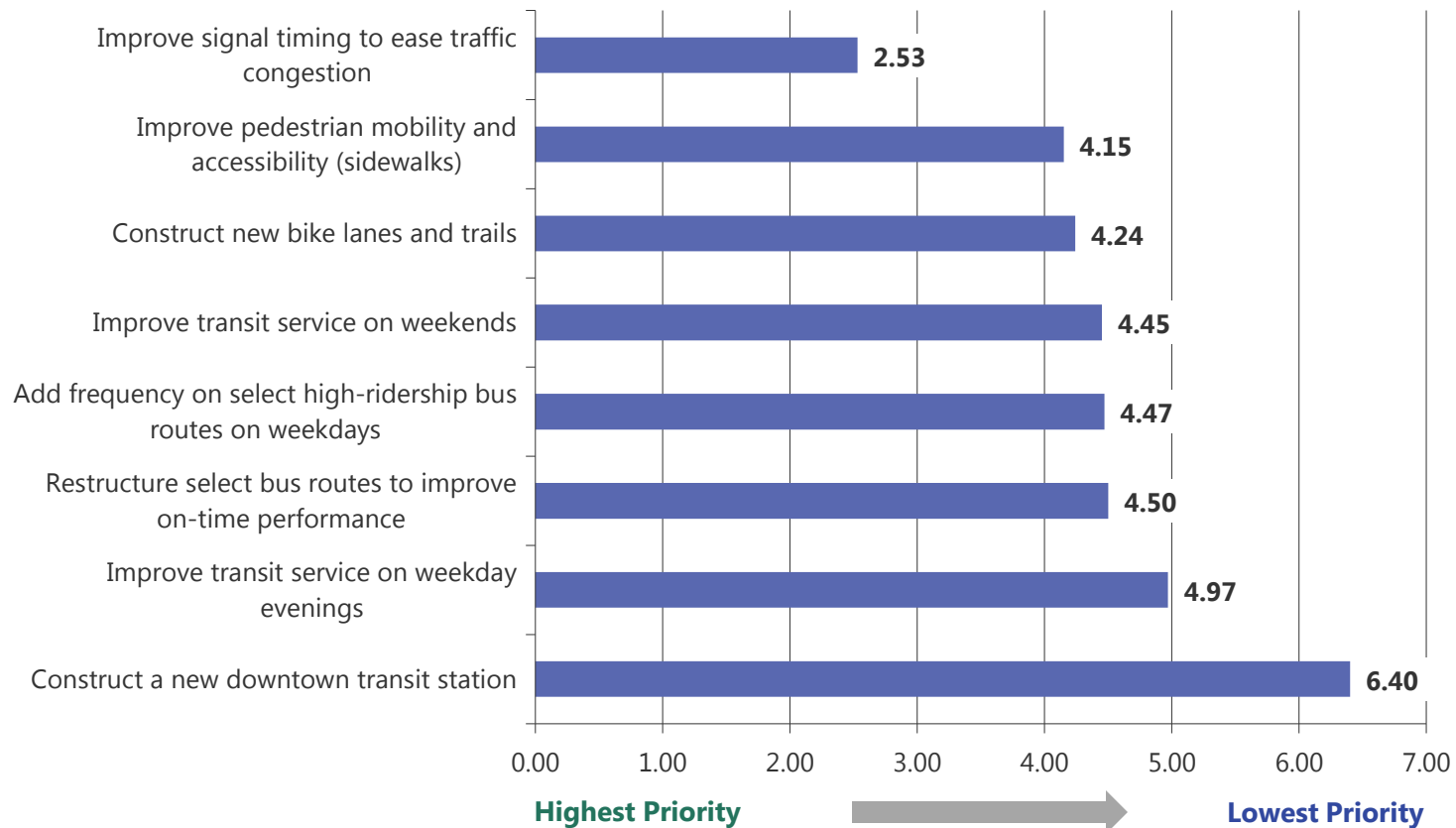
Q4: “How would you prioritize the following services and investments for City funding in 2016?”

(prioritized in rank order, with 1 being the highest)



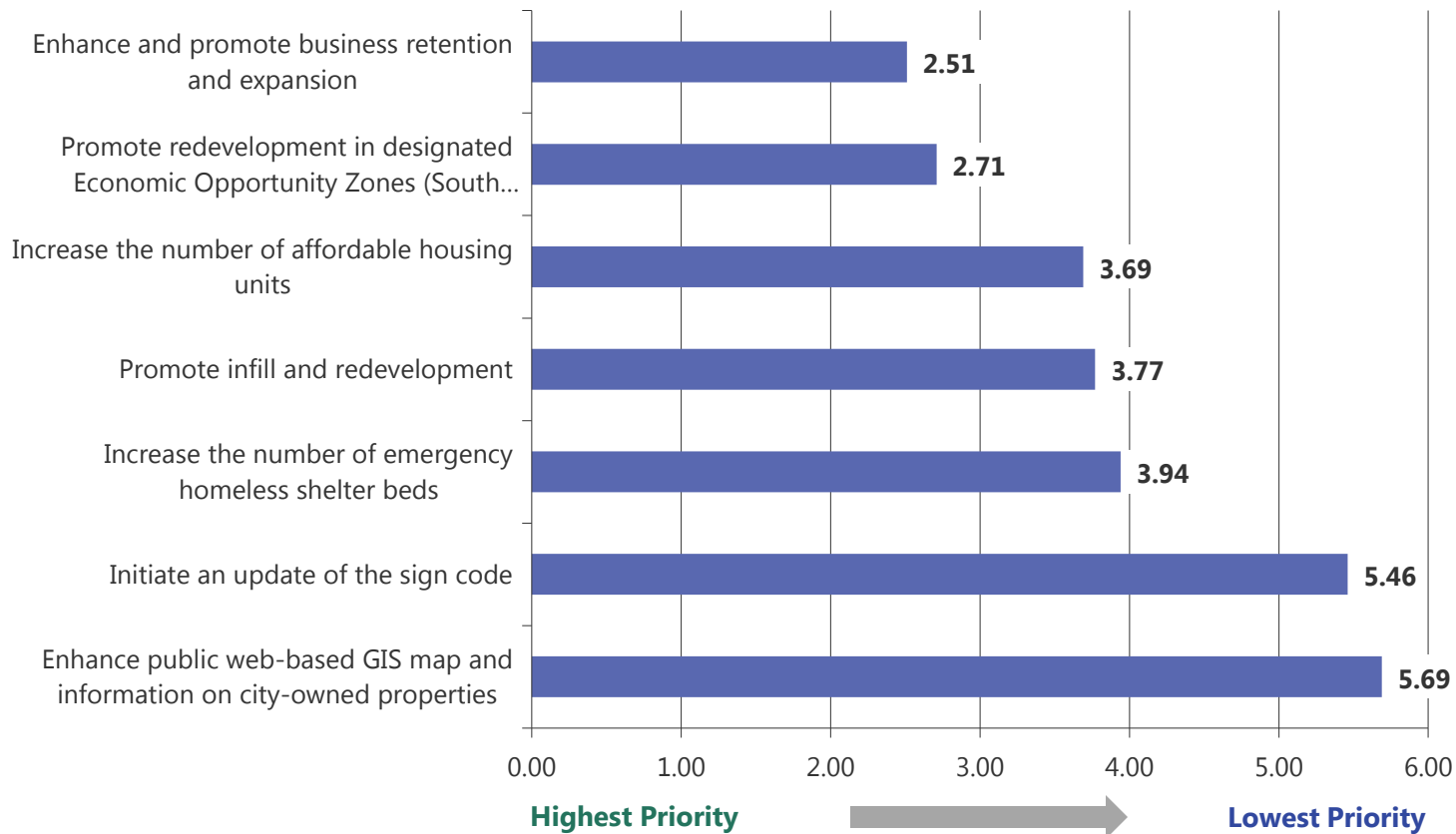
Q5: “How would you prioritize the following services and investments for City funding in 2016?”

“Fix the roads first”

- **“Potholes”, “roads”, & “traffic” frequent mentions**
 - Repairing roads, traffic enforcement on roads
 - Traffic lights/signal timing
 - Traffic patterns/design
- **“Parks” & “downtown” - mentioned frequently but context varied widely**
 - Build new parks, dogs in parks, tennis courts, law enforcement in parks, don't expand parks
 - Focus on downtown, beautify downtown, focus on other areas of town, free parking
