
OUR COMMUNITY

OUR COLLECTIVE IMPACT

Collectively, THFC and PMCN and now HFMN have directly assisted more than 210,000 service members, veterans and families since 2003 across all programs



Since 2004, we have provided more than \$5.8 million in emergency financial assistance to military and veteran families

Our partner agency network has assisted more than 420,000 since 2015




In the past 7 years, we have provided training to more than 1,800 partner agency participants



OUR DIRECT ASSISTANCE IMPACT

- ☐ HFMN experienced a nearly 300% increase in calls for assistance in 2020, handling more 4,700 unique callers
- ☐ HFMN experienced significant increases in referrals: referrals from HFMN to others increased 152%; and referrals from others to HFMN increased 72%

HFMN Assistance - 2014-2020




60% of callers affected by COVID-19

OUR DIRECT ASSISTANCE IMPACT, CONT'D

- □ Callers had complex needs, with many needing financial assistance and other services, including housing and employment, as well as behavioral health
- ☐ Historically, 10% of callers have needed more intensive navigation/case management support; in 2020, 36% of callers needed navigation services





68% of callers initially called for financial assistance

OUR DIRECT ASSISTANCE IMPACT, CONT'D

- ☐ HFMN provided more than \$348,000 in financial bridge support in 2020
- ☐ Impact of financial assistance is high, immediately following assistance and 6 months after assistance


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
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
2020 Financial Assistance Impact (at 6 Months)

- ☐ HFMN hosted 11 partner meetings (10 trainings) in 2020, providing knowledge to enable partners to better meet military and veteran needs
- ☐ Partner meetings are valued because of the resources, connections, networking opportunities, and people




