A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING NOVEMBER 3-7, 2025 AS
NATIONAL VETERANS SMALL BUSINESS WEEK

WHEREAS, the U.S. Small Business Administration has designated November 3 through November 7, 2025, as National Veterans Small Business Week, honoring the service members, veterans, members of the National Guard and Reserve, and military spouses who strengthen our communities and economy through entrepreneurship; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:


