EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 18-_____

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 17-116 (2018 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE AIRPORT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000,000 FOR CASUALTY REPAIRS RELATED TO THE APRIL 2018 FIRE AT THE COLORADO SPRINGS AIRPORT TERMINAL BUILDING

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. The Council finds that an emergency exists as a result of the fire at the Colorado Springs Airport Terminal Building in April 2018. Significant damage to Airport property has occurred and presents an urgent need for repairs to serve commercial aviation and the public. This emergency ordinance meets the requirements of City Charter §3-90 and City Code section 1.5.103 (B).

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 17-116 is hereby amended by increasing the revenue and expenditure appropriations in the amount of \$5,000,000 in the Airport Capital Improvement Program Fund for the sole purpose of funding repairs necessary to restore the Colorado Springs Airport Terminal Building to its original condition subsequent to the April 16, 2018 fire. The sources of funds are insurance proceeds and the available Airport Capital Improvement Program fund balance.

Section 3. In accord with City Charter §3-80 and §3-90, this emergency ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 4. Council deems it appropriate that this emergency ordinance be published on the following day or as soon thereafter as possible by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
