A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE  
MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND ADMINISTER AN  
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE  
CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS AND THE PIKES PEAK  
AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Colorado Springs ("City") is the primary source of clean, safe, and economical public transportation in the Pikes Peak region, providing fixed-route, complementary Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) paratransit, and alternative commuting services; and

WHEREAS, the Pikes Peak Area Council of Governments ("PPACG") currently receives and administers Area Agency on Aging (AAA) funds for seniors and has been designated by the Governor of Colorado as the regional recipient of 5310 funds for the Colorado Springs Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, the City currently administers the Specialized Transportation Program for the region; and

WHEREAS, administration of the Specialized Transportation Program will be transferred to PPACG in January 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City and PPACG are committed to a smooth transition of specialized transportation services to sustain the needs of seniors and people with disabilities in the region.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:**

Section 1. The City Council approves the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Colorado Springs and Pikes Peak Area Council of Governments regarding the transfer of Pikes Peak Rural Transportation Authority Transit funds for the Specialized Transportation Program, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

Section 2. Pursuant to City Code § 1.2.313, the Mayor has the authority to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City and shall administer its terms.
