Hi Dan,

The City of Colorado Springs was certified by the National Park Service in 1994 before the Old North End Historic District Design Guidelines (1995) or Design Standards (2000) were created. Therefore, they have no bearing on the City's certification unless new standards or guidelines are adopted that are not consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards and Guidelines for Archaeology and Historic Preservation (per Section II.A of the <u>CLG Handbook</u>). If the codified review standards are changed that could also affect the city's certification. As I mentioned in our conversation, I do have concerns about how and why this has all occurred but it seems to have stemmed from several misunderstandings and is not something that would necessitate decertification.
