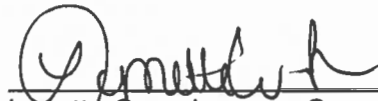

COLORADO SPRINGS:**

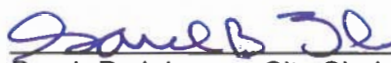
Section 1. City Council recognizes May 2026 as Historic Preservation Month.
