

RESOLUTION NO. 91-15

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NAMING OF THE SOUTHERN DELIVERY SYSTEM WATER TREATMENT FACILITY, THE "EDWARD W. BAILEY WATER TREATMENT PLANT

WHEREAS, Colorado Springs Utilities is constructing a Southern Delivery System water treatment facility northeast of the intersection of Marksheffel Road and Highway 94; and,

WHEREAS, the name "Edward W. Bailey Water Treatment Plant" satisfies the criteria established by the City Council of the City of Colorado Springs for the naming of a Colorado Springs Utilities facility; and,

WHEREAS, Edward W. Bailey served as the Director of Water Resources from 1972-1994 for Colorado Springs Utilities; he provided vision and direction for future water resource planning for our community; and,

WHEREAS, Under Mr. Bailey's leadership, Colorado Springs Utilities achieved numerous significant accomplishments ensuring a reliable long-term water supply for customers, including: 1) Completion of the Homestake Project; 2) Completion of Rampart Reservoir; 3) Completion of Pine Valley Water Treatment Plant; 4) Acquisition of the majority ownership of Twin Lakes Reservoir and Canal Company; 5) Completion of the Fountain Valley Water Treatment Plant; 6) Completion of Stanley Tunnel; and 7) Completion of McCullough Water Treatment Plant; and,

WHEREAS, During Mr. Bailey's tenure as the Director of Water Resources, CSU completed the 1996 Water Resource Plan which was adopted by City Council. The plan was developed to serve as the blueprint for ensuring Colorado Springs' future water needs through 2040 including the development of the Southern Delivery System.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:**

The Southern Delivery System water treatment facility will be named the "Edward W. Bailey Water Treatment Plant."
