## A RESOLUTION WITHDRAWING INDUSTRIAL SERVICE – INTERRUPTIBLE SALES (G3D) FROM THE COLORADO SPRINGS UTILITIES GAS SERVICE TARIFF

- **WHEREAS**, Colorado Springs Utilities (Utilities) provides Interruptible Gas Service within its service territory; and
- **WHEREAS**, Utilities currently offers three options (G2I, G3M and G3D) for Interruptible Gas Service in its tariffs; and
  - WHEREAS, Utilities currently has no customers on the G3D rate option; and
- **WHEREAS**, the G2I and G3M options provide reasonable alternatives for customers desiring interruptible gas service; and
- **WHEREAS**, Utilities proposes to and the Colorado Springs City Council finds it prudent to withdraw G3D service from its Natural Gas Service tariff; and
- **WHEREAS**, Colorado Springs City Code section 12.1.107(D)(2)(f) provides that the City Council may change any tariff provision which City Council, in its discretion, deems to be appropriate; provided, that the change has no adverse impact on customers; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the proposed modifications to the Natural Gas Rate Schedule will not adversely impact any customers and that no additional communication is required as no customers have selected or requested to select G3D Natural Gas service; and
- **WHEREAS**, the proposed modifications to the Natural Gas Rate Schedules are just, reasonable, sufficient and not unduly discriminatory and allow Utilities to collect revenues that enable Utilities to continue to operate in the best interest of all of its customers; and
  - WHEREAS, Utilities has proposed to make the G3D removal effective January 1, 2015.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1: The City Council hereby authorizes withdrawal of G3D service from Colorado Springs Utilities Natural Gas Tariff
