For starters every inch of open space with a mile of our home has been developed in the past two years. With the exception of the one park Near our home there is nowhere left to walk or play. This open space is a place that neighbors like to walk their dogs children like to ride their bikes. It's just breathing and the daily chaos of life. Furthermore, this piece of property floods, greatly every time it rains I can only imagine where all of that water is going to go when the land is developed , the traffic implications will also be great. It is already very difficult to turn. Left onto Chelton during rush-hour times. Adding 100+ more cars to this daily chaos is not going to improve matters. It is also not safe for pedestrians already.
