COMPREHENSIVE IGA



What is covered in the IGA:

- Budget submittal process
- Claims handling process
- Stipulates each member government follows its own procurement processes
- Warranties must name PPRTA as a beneficiary
- Stipulates PPRTA will not own property or facilities
- Submittal of quarterly reports
- PPRTA will honor member government record requests
- PPRTA will not pay for member government personnel
- Lists the specific capital projects eligible for funding

COMPREHENSIVE IGA



Why is it needed now:

- Incorporates the capital projects included in November 2022
- Updates City processes with form of government
- Minor clerical issues

COMPREHENSIVE IGA



What are the next steps:

- PPRTA Board approves the IGA – Completed September 11
- Resolution with Council – Scheduled for October 8
- Mayor Executes Comprehensive IGA – Following Council Approval
- Begin delivering PPRTA 3 Capital Projects – January 2025
