




Meeting the Needs of a Diverse and Aging Community

An AARP Age Friendly community recognizes the changing demographics of the United States and strives to be open and welcoming to people of all ages, abilities and mobilities. The Baby Boomer generation represents approximately 26% of the national population, and as they reach retirement age, we have witnessed a dramatic surge in the national senior population.¹ The AARP estimates that by 2035 the US population will be comprised more of older adults than of children.²

El Paso County is affected by this demographic shift as well. The population of residents 65 and older is projected to grow by 179% from 2015 to 2040.³ In the same time period, the population of residents 85 and older is projected to grow by 337%.


