My name is Rebekka Kanzler, and my address is 2103 Clarkson Dr., Colorado Springs, CO 80909. I currently hold a Regular Child Care License which allows for up to 8 children in my care. I am applying for a Large Child Care License which would allow for me to serve 4 additional children in my home. This would imply that I can serve a total of no more than 12 children at a time.

I am Large Daycare Center Director qualified and hold my BA in Early Childhood Education. My Regular Licensed Child Care Home has been in operation for the past 8 years without any complaints from my neighbors and/or clients. I frequently receive calls from potential clients requesting child care services, but under my current license I must turn them away. The approval from your department would allow me to serve my community just a little more. My program has achieved NAFCC Accreditation, 3 Diamond Rating with Colorado Shines, as well as the Early Head Start/Head Start Partnership.

Per licensing rules, I am required to have a 35sq. ft., per child indoor learning environment, as well as 75sq. ft., per child outdoor environment. I am certain that I exceed the aforementioned requirements regarding square footage to serve the additional children requested. I will not be making any changes to the structure of the home or the property. I do have off street parking available for my family as well as my clients.
