

- Metropolitan districts for two different Nor'wood (Banning Lewis Ranch) metropolitan district areas requesting debt authorization
  - Freestyle
  - Meadoworks
- For both cases:
  - Marketed; tax-exempt
  - Issued by one district-- with pledges from certain (but not all) other districts
  - Pledges of 33.398 debt service mill levy (Gallagher adjusted) in all cases
  - Project funds primarily for future improvements
- Similar request for North Meadow (Percheron) may come next month



#### **Summary-** Continued



- Two options being carried forward in both cases:
  - Single cash flow bond, or
  - Senior and subordinate bonds (see applicant presentation)
  - Potential interest rates
    - A bonds- 5%
    - B bonds- 8%
    - Single cash flow- 5.75%
  - 30-year terms
- Cash flow option preferred, subject to marketing
  - Because it presumably will generate a larger project fund revenues

#### **Summary-** Continued



- Freestyle Metropolitan District
  - Issued by District No. 2 with pledges from District Nos. 3 and 4
  - Not to exceed \$53,600,000
- Meadoworks Metropolitan District
  - Issued by District No. 2
  - Not to exceed \$43,000,000

-all of these are residential districts- with 40-year maximum debt service mill levy imposition terms

### **Debt Service Caps**



- Maximum Debt Service Caps in Service Plans
  - Freestyle-
    - no district-specific caps
    - \$185 Million for combined districts
  - Meadoworks
    - no district-specific caps
    - \$400 Million for combined districts

## **Development Approval Status**



- Freestyle
  - Master plan and zoning in place for part of this project area
- Meadoworks
  - Detailed development plans moving forward based on existing MP and zoning
- About 5,000 dwelling units projected in total for the 2 projects from 2023-2030
