

ORDINANCE NO. 14-_____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 204 (EMPLOYEE INSURANCE BENEFITS) OF PART 2 (SALARIES AND BENEFITS) OF ARTICLE 4 (CITY EMPLOYEES) OF CHAPTER 1 (ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND FINANCE) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO BENEFITS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 204 (Employee Insurance Benefits) of Article 4 (City Employees) of Chapter 1 (Administration, Personnel, and Finance) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, are hereby amended to read as follows:

1.4.204: EMPLOYEE INSURANCE BENEFITS:

B. Group Medical Plans: The City shall offer group medical plans to all regular, special and probationary employees who are employed to work twenty (20) or more hours per week, **and hourly employees who are eligible for benefits as required by applicable state or federal law.** These employees may voluntarily enroll in one of the City's group medical plans. The City shall contribute an amount as set forth in the annual appropriation ordinance toward an employee's monthly medical premium.

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Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
