Subject: Electric Contract Service Tariff

1. The USAF Academy requests a tariff reintroduction to allow CSU to complete several projects related to our privatization efforts. This includes the enhancement of the overhead electric line between switch 34C18-2 and Air West substation and two smaller incidental projects. Proposed efforts will improve electric reliability servicing the Academy and be a one-time billing of \$575,000.
2. The proposed tariff reintroduction is recommended for approval at the 28 February 2017 City Council meeting.
3. As the USAF Academy finalizes our privatization efforts, these projects focus on improving reliability and reducing the potential for power outages. This action complies with the USAF's privatization directives as well as providing safe and reliable power.
4. We firmly support the proposed tariff reintroduction to bill USAF Academy for these projects. Academy contracting officials will be present at the 28 February 2017 City Council meeting to support the proposed tariff reintroduction.
