AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 10-48 and  
12-20 DISSOLVING THE HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, City Council created the Human Relations Commission with the passage of Ordinance 10-48 on June 8, 2010 and further amended the legislation with Ordinance 12-20 on March 27, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Springs City Council recognizes the importance of human relations. However, after a thorough review and stakeholder process, City Council has determined the Human Relations Commission no longer serves a legislative function as it relates to City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Ordinance Nos. 10-48 and 12-20 are repealed, and the Human Relations Commission is hereby dissolved. City Council thanks the members of the Human Relations Commission for their time and service.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the Office of the City Clerk.
