

### Summary



- Increases the combined over debt limit for North Meadow Metropolitan Districts Nos. 1-5 from \$145,000,000 to \$200,000,000
- Eliminates district-specific debt limits
- City Council District No. 6

## Background



- Districts originally approved in early 2021
  - District No. 1- Operating
  - District Nos. 2-4 Residential
  - District No. 5 Commercial

#### Original Caps

District No. 1	no authorization
	<b>A</b> 04 000 000 <b>A=</b> 4 000

District No. 3 \$45,000,000

District No. 4 \$18,000,000 or \$41,000,000\*

District No. 5 \$23,000,000

Combined Total \$145,000,000\*\*

<sup>\*\*</sup> sum of maximum individual amounts would be \$160,000,000

### Other Information



- Similar language and structure are already in place for for Freestyle and Meadoworks Metropolitan Districts
- Limited amendment process
  - Remainder of service plan would be unchanged
- Updated cost estimates provided
  - Along with a sample 2022 and 2032 bond run
- This will allow the pending large issuance proposed for District No. 5 with pledges from District Nos. 3 and 4.
