- 5 acres undeveloped






- 1895 Fairview established


Burials and Cremations (2012-2021)

Increasing Expenses



- Evergreen Cemetery uses non-potable water which has increased 29% over the past five (5) years.
- Fairview Cemetery uses potable water which has increased 28% over the past five (5) years.
- Capital needs vehicle replacement and cremation features.
- Operating needs staffing costs increased through wage increases and City compensation increases, and 82% increase in mowing contract.
