A RESOLUTION FIXING AND CERTIFYING THE 2022
ANNUAL ASSESSMENT MILL LEVY FOR ASSESSMENTS
PAYABLE IN 2023 AT 13.416 MILLS UPON EACH DOLLAR
OF ASSESSED VALUATION WITHIN THE OLD
COLORADO CITY SECURITY & MAINTENANCE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 3-7-108 of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, City Council shall fix a rate of assessment within the district and shall raise the amount required by the district during the ensuing fiscal year to meet the cost of maintaining and securing the public improvements included in the district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

- Section 1. That the City Council determines the amount of money to be raised by the assessment mill levy for the Old Colorado City Security & Maintenance District (District) for the ensuing year is the sum of \$128,154.
- Section 2. That for the purpose of maintaining and securing the public improvements included in the District, an assessment mill levy for the Year 2022, to be collected in the same manner as a tax levy, shall be fixed at 13.416 mills upon each dollar of assessed valuation of property within the District for collection in 2023.
- Section 3. That the City is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of El Paso County Commissioners in accordance with Section 3-7-108 of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended.
