Action Plan Process

- Program Year is April 1 to March 31
- Five Year Consolidated Plan drives priorities (2010-2014)
- Public input process outlined in Citizen Participation Plan
 - Conduct community meetings year-round
 - Conduct public hearing with City Council through the City budget process
 - Post budget and activities for public comment; review public comments
 - City Council approves budget and activities
 - Draft plan narrative
 - Publish narrative for a 30-day comment period
 - Review public comments and respond (included in final plan)
 - Submit final plan to HUD
