#### **ORDINANCE NO. 15-18**

# AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PLATTING OF BLOCKS 203, 212 AND 213 IN EVERGREEN CEMETERY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That through this platting additional casket, cremation and infant spaces is hereby made available at Evergreen Cemetery. This ordinance will hereby approve the plat of Blocks 203, 212 and 213 at said Evergreen Cemetery.

## Section 2. Block 203 is hereby platted as follows:

Block 203 shall consist of casket burial spaces with a standard size of four feet by ten feet.

There will be 192 burial spaces.

### Section 3. Block 212 is hereby platted as follows:

Block 212 shall consist of casket burial spaces with a standard size of four feet by ten feet.

There will be 1,094 adult casket spaces.

Burial spaces within one space of the surrounding roads can be utilized for Double Depth burials as well as any other space in that section with the approval of the Cemetery Sexton.

There will be 141 four foot by six foot burial spaces dedicated for the interment of children's caskets or cremated remains.

There will be 186 two foot by six foot burial spaces for the interment of infants or cremated remains that will require a flat or flush with the ground headstone no greater in size than 8 inches by 18 inches.

## Section 4. Block 213 is hereby platted as follows:

Block 213 shall consist of casket burial spaces with a standard size of four feet by ten feet.

There will be 383 adult casket spaces.

Section 5. Within Blocks 203, 212 and 213, the cemetery will require a City approved burial vault for all adult casket burials unless waived for religious reasons, in which case a vault can be substituted with the cemetery's Tamping Fee.

Within said blocks, for the casket spaces the monuments and markers shall not exceed three-fourths of the overall width of the space of the space(s) purchased as well as a 48-inch height restriction. All monuments and markers shall be placed on the west end of the grave marked. All monuments and markers shall be made of granite, bronze, marble or quartzite and no temporary markers will be allowed. All monuments and markers shall require foundations to be built to cemetery specifications. If vases are desired, they must be made of granite, marble or die-cast zinc.

Section 6. Within Blocks 203, 212 and 213, no vases or urns will be allowed to be set in or on the ground; vases must be attached to the upright stone or attached to the base. No corner markers will be allowed. No mausoleums are permitted. No trellises, bushes, trees, roses, shrubs, perennials or any spreading plants of any kind will be allowed. Planting of annual flowers will be allowed six inches to the east of an upright monument or marker but no borders or edging will be allowed. There will be no plantings by flat headstones allowed.

Section 7. The platting of said Blocks 203, 212 and 213, and the spaces therein, is presented to City Council and the same is hereby approved.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 9. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.




