

Barnes Center Vicinity Map






Barnes Center Apartments

 - Master planned for Multi-family 12-24 du/ac
- Applications
 - Zone change from A to R-5 (multi-family residential)
 - Amendment to the concept plan for the commercial property to the south.
 - Development plan for an apartment complex.

Concept Plan amendment area


Concept Plan Amendment

- Change to the road alignment for Integrity Center Point.
- •Creation of open space and drainage along the west boundary.



Development Plan

- 272 unit apartment complex
- Access from Barnes on Integrity Center Pt.
- No access from Integrity Center Point to Chaparral.
- Detention in southwest corner of site.




Code requirements:


- Harmonious

Proposed project:

- Sound wall and berm along Powers
- Apartment complex structures, detention pond, and Integrity Center Point provide a buffer for properties to the west
- 6' cedar fence and grade change buffer property to the north
- Northeast corner of site grade 6776
- finished floor of first building 6,742 - 30' tall to peak
- Finished floor of first large building - 6,743 - 40' tall to peak










Northeast of Bridlespur and Tutt





Traffic

- Signalized intersection at Barnes and Integrity Center Pt
- Signal at Barnes and Chaparral/Rio Vista
- Access to Commercial property to the north via Integrity Center Point, but no access to Chaparral.
- Integrity Center Point built to the apartment complex
- North of Apartment complex
 - developer responsible for
 - sidewalk, curb & gutter on east side
 - grading of roadway
 - Property owner to the north
 - Curb & gutter on west side
 - asphalt mat




CITY OF COLORADO

El Paso County & State Water Resources

- El Paso County Review supportive of project and felt the project did a good job of buffering.
- State Water Resources no adverse impact to neighboring properties with construction of new apartments.

Drainage

- The drainage design for this site is per a Master Development Drainage Plan (MDDP) that was previously approved by the City in February 2014.
- The specific drainage associated with this apartment site is in compliance with that MDDP and is also approved by the City.
- The site drainage design accounts for both the apartment site developed flows and the historic flows that drain onto this site.
