## ORDINANCE NO. 15-\_\_\_\_\_

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 14-101 (2015 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000,000 FOR THE RESPONSE AND REPAIR REQUIRED AFTER THE MAY 2015 HEAVY RAIN STORMS AND FLOODING

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That an emergency exists as a result of the heavy rain storms and flooding that occurred in May, 2015. Significant damage occurred to City infrastructure and property, such as roads, bridges, waterways, trails, and park structures. The Mayor signed a Proclamation and Declaration of Emergency on May 18, 2015. This emergency ordinance meets the requirements of City Charter §3-90.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 14-101 is hereby amended by increasing the General Fund expenditure appropriation in the amount of \$5,000,000 (\$4,000,000 for Public Works and \$1,000,000 for Parks) for response and repairs required after the May 2015 heavy rain storms and flooding. The source of General Fund monies is the General Fund available fund balance.

Section 3. In accord with City Charter §3-90, this emergency ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption.

Section 4. Council deems it appropriate that this emergency ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
