
- 2,698 responses (0.6% of the population)


#### Q1: "How would you prioritize the following services and investments for City funding in 2016?"

(prioritized in rank order, with 1 being the highest)






# Q2: "How would you prioritize the following services and investments for City funding in 2016?" (prioritized in rank order, with 1 being the highest)






# Q3: "How would you prioritize the following services and investments for City funding in 2016?" (prioritized in rank order, with 1 being the highest)







#### "Fix the roads first"

#### • "Potholes", "roads", & "traffic" frequent mentions

- Repairing roads, traffic enforcement on roads
- Traffic lights/signal timing
- Traffic patterns/design
- "Parks" & "downtown" mentioned frequently but context varied widely
  - Build new parks, dogs in parks, tennis courts, law enforcement in parks, don't expand parks
  - Focus on downtown, beautify downtown, focus on other areas of town, free parking
