ORDINANCE NO. 15-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 7 (SALES AND USE TAX) OF CHAPTER 2 (BUSINESS LICENSING, LIQUOR REGULATION AND TAXATION) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO A CHANGE TO THE SALES AND USE TAX RATE FROM TWO AND FIVE-TENTHS PERCENT (2.5%) TO THREE AND TWELVE ONE-HUNDREDTHS PERCENT (3.12%)

WHEREAS, at the November 3, 2015, special municipal election, the voters of the City approved a ballot question authorizing a temporary additional levy of sixty-two one-hundredths percent (0.62%) in City sales and use tax dedicated solely to road repair, maintenance and improvements and constituting a voter approved revenue change exempt from spending and revenue limitations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. The rate of sales and use tax is amended from two and five-tenths percent (2.5%) to three and twelve one-hundredths percent (3.12%) in the following Sections of Article 7 (Sales and Use Tax) of Chapter 2 (Business Licensing, Liquor Regulation and Taxation) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended: §§ 2.7.103, 2.7.201, 2.7.406, 2.7.434, 2.7.444, 2.7.446, 2.7.602, 2.7.808.

Section 2. Section 203 (Tax Bracket Schedule) of Part 2 (Tax Imposed; Tax Rate) of Article 7 (Sales and Use Tax) of Chapter 2 (Business Licensing, Liquor Regulation and Taxation) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:
