ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 206 (PARKING EXEMPT DISTRICTS) OF PART 2 (OFF STREET PARKING STANDARDS) OF ARTICLE 4 (SITE DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS) OF CHAPTER 7 (PLANNING, DEVELOPMENT AND BUILDING) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO THE OLD COLORADO CITY PARKING EXEMPT DISTRICT


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 206 (Parking Exempt Districts) of Part 2 (Off Street Parking Standards) of Article 4 (Site Development Standards) of Chapter 7 (Planning, Development and Building) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

7.4.206: Parking Exempt Districts

B. Old Colorado City District: The area bounded on the north by the south line of West Pikes Peak Avenue, on the south by the north line of West Cucharras Street, on the east by the west line of South 24th Street, on the west by the east line of 26th Street. The district also includes the half-block bounded at the west by the east side of South 27th Street, bounded at the north by the south line of the alley between West Colorado Avenue and West Pikes Peak Avenue, the half-block bounded at the south by the north line of the alley between West Colorado Avenue and West Cucharras Street, and at the east by the east side of South 26th Street



Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
