- Development of a strategic direct and indirect economic development incentives plan
- Consideration of impacts on existing neighborhoods, and local community corrections programs
- Consideration of the of the National Cybersecurity Center

"Convenient, central location in Co Springs ripe for infill development. Close to UCCS, I-25, and Penrose Hospital."


