	Two bids received by Procurement Office
April 18	Second community meeting held at Westside Community Center. Park staff presented the public comments to date as well as three alternative plans for public feedback
April 24	Bancroft Park Action Plan activity report update presented to City Council
April 26	Notice of Award issued to Murphy Construction. Murphy begins process to provide insurance and bonding
