

Mobile Food Vendor A Brief History

One of the oldest business types licensed through the City Clerk's Office

Licensed in one form or another since 1893, including:

- Peddling Fruits and Vegetables 1893
- Hucksters and Hawkers 1895
- Peddler of Foodstuffs 1998
- Peddler of Food Wares 2006
- Mobile Food Vendor 2017 (proposed)



Mobile Food Vendor A Brief History

- In late 2014, the General Business License Code was updated to standardize requirements and fees necessary to regulate activities related to health, safety, or other protective services, with specific license type codes to have further license specific updates in the future.
- Current City Code prohibits a Peddler from occupying metered parking spaces to conduct business, and the City and Downtown Partnership have received numerous requests for permission to use metered parking spots for special occasions.
- Discussion on potential changes to the parking meter prohibition presents a prime opportunity to update the peddler code for archaic terms and definitions, as well as to clarify prohibitions.



Mobile Food Vendor License Code Changes

- Change name from "Peddler of Food Wares" to "Mobile Food Vendor"
- Clarifies definitions
- Clarifies intent to maintain free flow of traffic and to prohibit activities in or toward a street or roadway
- Changes prohibition on operating from metered parking spaces to allow special occasion use with the approval and permit of Parking Enterprise
- Changes license fees code section to match the updated license type name (separate ordinance)


Parking Meter Hood Application





Parking Old Colorado Gity's Food Truck Map






- Who can request:
 - Brick and Mortar establishments that are adjacent to metered parking stalls
- When:
 - 2x a calendar year
 - **12** Hour duration



- Steps to obtain a Permit
- 1. Application must be filled out and approved by the Planning Dept.
- 2. Parking Enterprise: Hoods
 - Fee \$6 per hood (2-4 needed) \$12-\$24
 - Agree to rules and regulation
