AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 308 (OFFICE OF TRAFFIC ENGINEER) OF PART 3 (ADMINISTRATION) OF ARTICLE 1 (ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT) OF CHAPTER 10 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO THE TRAFFIC ENGINEER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 308 (Office of Traffic Engineer) of Part 3 (Administration) of Article 1 (Administration and Enforcement) of Chapter 10 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

10.1.308: OFFICE OF TRAFFIC ENGINEER:

The Office of the Traffic Engineer is hereby created. The Traffic Engineer shall be appointed by and report directly to the Mayor Public Works Director, and shall exercise the powers granted in this chapter, consistent with the provisions of the City Charter.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City

Clerk.
