

## Background



- City Sign ordinance updated in 2012
  - Sign enforcement program was established
- $\circ~$  Proactive site inspections are performed
- $\,\circ\,$  Site inspection at 1624 North Academy on June 14, 2017
  - Multiple temporary banner signs displayed on the north, east and west elevations of the tenant space
- $\,\circ\,$  Notice and Order issued on June 23  $\,$
- Per current code 7.4.409(B)(3)(g) Commercial Centers or properties that incorporate an Electronic Message Center (digital sign) are prohibited to display temporary signs such as banners, inflatables or a-frame signs.

## **Property Permit History**

Polo Center legally permitted 2 EMC's in August 2012

- EMC approval requires submittal of an Electronic Message Center Compliance Affidavit
  - Criteria that must be maintained for the approval of EMC's
  - Affidavit notes that temporary signage is prohibited on any property that has an approved EMC
  - Signed by the property owner
- City Code regulates signage based on placement and property as a whole.

## **Issued Notice and Order**



- 15 banners displayed at the Aim Inc. tenant space:
  - Five banners per elevation
  - A total combined area of 996 square feet
- City Code Section 7.4.409(B)(3)(g)
  - Square footage of allowable temporary signage
  - When no EMC sign on-site
  - Up to 242.25 square feet of temporary banner signage
  - Aim is 3X over standard sign allowance if the site was not permitted for an EMC
- Options for Aim:
  - Permit permanent signage
  - $\circ~$  Window signage allowed up to 25% of each window per elevation
  - o 277 square feet allowed which exceeds any standard banner allowance
  - (IF this tenant was not in a center with an EMC)

### Recommendation



- City Planning Commission Appeal heard on August 17<sup>th</sup>.
  - CPC voted 5-0 to deny the appeal and uphold the Notice and Order
- Staff recommends denial of the appeal, thus upholding the notice and order
  - Note that as of the Council hearing the banners have been displayed 104 day
  - Code stipulates 90 days when temporary signs are permitted
