## **Supplemental Appropriation to 2018 HUD Federal Entitlement Grants**

## **Relevant Background Information**

The federal program year for the CDBG, HOME, and ESG entitlement grants is April 1 to March 31. Each year, the City's Original Budget is prepared based on estimated entitlement allocations. The actual allocations are received from HUD in approximately April of each year, therefore the Amended City Budget may reflect a significant difference from the Original Budget to align the City budget with the actual allocation amounts. When allocations are higher than the Original City Budget, City Council must appropriate the difference by means of a supplemental approriation to allow for full spending authority of the grant funds.
