


Average Traffic Counts (Northbound)


Total Weekday Ridership for Routes 1, 5, 25 & 27






Pedestrian Signal Activations




Average Pedestrian Signal Activations Per Hour








Percentage of City Crime Occuring Within the Academy Planning Area




