announcements, social media, and printed materials. The public service announcement includes a variety of local Coloradoans addressing various forms of abuse and reiterating the message "it's"

not okay", and that if they abuse, they can get help; and

including a youth-focused pilot program with Harrison School District 2, an elite training team to provide presentations throughout the community, and a workplace campaign.
