ORDINANCE NO. 19-____

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY DESCRIBED AS A PORTION OF TEJON PLACE AND THE ADJACENT TEN FOOT ALLEYS SOUTH OF EAST NAVAJO STREET AND EAST OF SOUTH TEJON STREET WITHIN THE MADDOCK'S ADDITION TO IVYWILD AND THE WILLIAMSONS'S ADDITION TO IVYWILD CONSISTING OF 0.104 OF AN ACRE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. City Council hereby finds, determines and declares that it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to vacate and hereby vacates a public right-ofway described as a portion of Tejon Place and the adjacent ten foot alleys south of East Navajo Street and east of South Tejon Street within the Maddock's Addition to Ivywild and the Williamson's Addition to Ivywild consisting of 0.104 of an acre, as described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B, both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, subject to the reservations of easement set forth in Section 2, below.

Section 2. Council accepts and reserves from this vacation public utility easements over, under and through the vacated portions of rights-of-way described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B, subject to those terms and conditions as set forth in that certain instrument filed in the public records of El Paso County, Colorado at Reception No. 217138897.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 4. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the Office of the City Clerk.
