
Summary

Background on BIDs



- Created under State statute
- 11 Total in the City
 - 10 are development-specific
 - All these have elected boards
 - Exception is Greater Downtown BID
- Can only tax non-residential properties
- Governed by Council-approved annual Operating Plans and Budgets
 - Standard format documents

Background on this BIDLORADO

- This BID created in 2004
- Authorized to impose operational mill levy of 1.0 mills and debt service levy of up to 50.0 mills
 - Only the operational levy has been certified to-date
 - No formal debt issuances; although there are developer advances
- Development status
