

### Evergreen Cemetery





- 1875 Evergreen established
- 1993 Evergreen placed on National Register of Historic Places
- 185 acres
- Approx. 85,000 occupied spaces
- 30 to 40 years of inventory remaining –
   8000 spaces within developed areas
- 5 acres undeveloped




### Fairview Cemetery






- 1895 Fairview established
- 1917 Annexed by the City
- 28 acres
- Approx. 12,500 occupied grave spaces
- 1 to 2 years of inventory remaining
   approx. 1,000 spaces



### Service Levels




#### CEMETERY ENTERPRISE (1999 THRU 2017)



### Revenue vs Expenditure




#### **CEMETERY ENTERPRISE REVENUE VS EXPENDITURE (1999 - 2017)**



# Fees and Charges ProcessoloRADO SPRINGS

### Apply a strategy to determine how best to provide services effectively and efficiently

- a) Alignment with organizational purpose Does the service support the Department's mission statement?
- b) Financial viability Is the service self-sustaining or does it have the capacity to be?
- c) Market position What is the service's current market position?
- d) Other key provider/competitor coverage How much competition exists and to what degree?
- e) Application of Department and City Revenue and Fee Policies

### City User Fee Policy



- Previously, no user fee policy
- Provides general guidelines for establishing a fee structure for all departments of the City
- Cost recovery levels identified to provide guidance for all departments of the City
- Establishes review process for fee policy

### User Fee Policy – Cost Recovery Levels



Cost Recovery Levels	Cost Recovery Percentage Range	Policy Considerations
Low	0% - 29%	<ul> <li>There is a community-wide benefit to the service</li> <li>The fee will discourage compliance with regulatory requirements</li> <li>Collecting fee is not cost effective</li> <li>Public goods</li> </ul>
Medium	30% - 69%	<ul> <li>Services having factors associated with the low and high cost recovery levels</li> </ul>
High	70% - 100%	<ul> <li>The service has attributes similar to services available in the private sector (therefore the government should not subsidize a service that the private sector provides)</li> <li>Those individuals receiving the benefit of the service pay the cost of the service</li> <li>The goal is to discourage use of a service or at least limit demand</li> <li>The service is regulatory in nature</li> </ul>

### Increasing Expenses



- Prices have not been increased since 2010/2015.
- Evergreen Cemetery uses nonpotable water which has increased 30% over the past five (5) years.
- Fairview Cemetery uses potable water which has increased 27% over the past five (5) years.
- Capital needs asphalt road repair/replacement at both locations, vehicle replacement, and cremation features.
- Operating needs staffing cost increases through minimum wage increases and City compensation increases, and 3% increase in mowing contract.
