To Whom It May Concern:

We are serving as counsel to Banning Lewis Ranch Metropolitan District No. 4, Banning Lewis Ranch Metropolitan District No. 5 and Banning Lewis Ranch Regional Metropolitan District (collectively, the "Districts"), generally and in connection with the issuance by the Districts of the above-referenced Bonds (collectively, the "Bonds").

As part of the development of the Districts, certain public improvements have been constructed over the years and additional public improvements continue to be constructed. The Districts have had the eligible public improvement costs verified and certified by the Districts' accountant, CliftonLarsonAllen, CPA's. The Districts now seek to issue the Bonds in order to accomplish reimbursement of a portion of the costs of the public improvements, as contemplated in the Districts' Service Plan.
