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## Summary



- Existing metropolitan districts
- Amendment to allow street operations and maintenance as an authorized function
- Limited amendment document; balance of the service plan would remain in force and effect

## Background



- Project now called "Victory Ridge"
- Mixed use development approved in 2005
- Districts approved in 2006
  - District No. 1 Operating
  - District No. 2 Residential
  - District No. 3 Commercial
- Conformed with Model Service Plan
- October 2016 Amendment to allow increase of operating mill levy to 20.0 mills/ maintenance of parking structure
  - 6-2 vote
- 2017 Bond issuance \$14,781,000


### Area and district map (2016) COLORADO





#### Area and district map






## Specific Issues and Discussion
