Community Impact of Velodrome



- Community programs (1,200+ hrs/year)

- 55% increase in unique members from 2014
- Weekly Roller Sport practice

Team USA Athlete Impact

- 2016 Summer Olympic Games
 - Two silver medals
- 2016 Summer Paralympic Games
 - One gold, two silver, and two bronze medals
- Number of camps hosted at velodrome have doubled since 2013
- 269% increase in the number of Olympic/Paralympic athletes since 2013
- Over 600 top riders from across the United States travel to Colorado Springs each year
- 31 National Records & 10 World Records under the dome
- Development site for new USA Cycling Olympic Development Program
- International usage




Dome Improvements - Permanency

- Eliminate interruptions to elite and community training due to weather (4 – 6 weeks)
- Eliminate interruptions to training for tear-down and set-up (up to 6 weeks)
- Year-round technological testing due to controlled environment
 - Layered video analysis
 - On-track aerodynamic testing
- Less wear and tear on dome material (20 yr expected)
- Reduced yearly costs
- Only one of three covered velodromes in the U.S.
- All costs will be paid for by the USOC



Dome – Additional Improvements



- ADA updates to building:
 - Add new accessible restroom to grandstand
- ADA updates to parking:
 - Regrade, striping and add curb cuts
 - Add 2 ADA parking spaces
- Electrical upgrades in dome:
 - Additional outlets for events
 - Safety: Eliminate the use of extension chords
- IT cabling & network upgrades to increase connectivity

Benefits to Dome Permanency

- Year-round training
- Increased community program availability
- Increased Team USA training opportunities
- Improved accessibility
