## **Vicinity Map**






### **Summary and Benefits**



- A Resolution Authorizing the Acquisition of Two Parcels of Land Totaling Approximately 1.744 Acres of Real Property and a Temporary Construction Easement Containing Approximately 0.212 Acres from Heriberto Lopez and Blanca F. Magallan Velasquez (Owners)
- Properties are needed to construct Regional Flood Control (Pond PR-2) Storm Water Impoundment in Cottonwood Creek as identified and obligated with the IGA with Pueblo County
- Owner has agreed to sell Parcel to the City for \$100,000
- Project will provide Flood Control in Cottonwood Creek for 6 square mile watershed (85% Developed). Reduction of 12 % in flow for 100-year return storm
- Tutt Boulevard will be extended and existing Old Cowpoke bridge will be removed
- Project will provide Tier One Trail (Cottonwood Creek Trail)
  Pedestrian Tunnel under Tutt Boulevard Extension


